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## Program Overview

This informative one-day program is the thirteenth in a series of conferences focusing on special health concerns of minorities in North Carolina and the Southeast. This year's conference addresses three topics of vital importance for minority health:

- ◆ Provision of health care services in rural areas.
- ◆ Health promotion and disease prevention for African-American males.
- ◆ Cancer control in minorities.

The conference will involve participants from diverse settings. Participants who are invited to attend include people working in public health, occupational health, community health, rural health, human services, and education. ## Objectives

The purpose of this program is to:

- ◆ Raise awareness about issues central to minority health.
- ◆ Provide a forum for discussing innovative approaches to meeting minority health needs.
- ◆ Enable participants to network and discuss minority health issues.
- ◆ Present public health career opportunities to minority students.
