

## Sample Output Reports

This section contains sample pages from reports produced by the Bibliographic (MARC) Processing System. Most of these reports were produced by the programs of the Retrieval Cycle, including the Sort Key Edit program (BPSSKED) and the Print program (BPSprt). The following guide to the sample reports is organized according to their intended use, e.g., for library patrons, library cataloging and indexing staff, or other (non-bibliographic) uses.

### Sample reports

#### A. For library patrons:

1. Acquisitions list, dated November-December 1975.

A full citation display, in title order, of citations selected according to acquisition date. Name, subject, area, and series indices are also provided (see below).

2. List of acquisitions, October 1972.

An alternate format for displaying citations. Citations are grouped by subject category. The explanatory text that appears on the first page is printed by the Print program as part of the report title.

3. PopScan Bibliographic retrieval on Intrauterine devices from 05/31/74.

A full citation printout, in title order, with citations selected according to the content (in this case) of the title (numeric tag 245) and subject terms (numeric tags in the 600 series). Selection was accomplished using the Free-Text Search program (BPSRET), the search statements for which have been affixed at the head of the bibliography.

PopScan bibliographies are generally accompanied by name, subject, and geographical area indices (see below).

4. Name, Subject, Area, and Series Indices (November-December 1975).

Index reports list each reference number from a previously printed report (in this example, the Acquisitions List referred to in item 1) under each subject or other dimension. An index can be produced for any tagged field or fields. For the TIS-CPC PopScan Bibliographies, name subject and area indices are standard.

5. List of PopScan Bibliographies (November 1975).

To produce this list, each PopScan Bibliography that has been retained by the TIS-CPC Library as a reference document is entered as a citation in the catalog. This list of PopScans is ordered by subject and title. Only selected information from each citation is printed. Explanatory information on the first page is printed as part of the report title.

6. Key Word In Context (KWIC) listing of titles.

This list is produced by the Key Word In Context program (BPSKWIC). In this example, a line has been generated for each word in each title and subject term. KWIC lines are formatted so that the "key" word is in the center and the words that preceded it (the "precontext") are printed to the left, separated by an extra blank space. The "postcontext" appears to the right. The did and call numbers are printed at the left margin.

B. For library cataloging and indexing staff:

1. CPC-TIS Authority List (nme, sue, tiln, tien) 08/23/75

A listing of all names in the data base, for standardization purposes. The did number and field identification are listed for each occurrence of the name, so that corrections may be marked directly on the report and then entered into the Update Cycle. Call numbers and journal source are provided to facilitate manual verification of correct spelling, etc., of the name.

This listing might also be of use to catalogers in other libraries.

2. set/see list, til list (of tie recs).

These are examples of special purpose listings that assist in standardization and verification of cataloging accuracy.

3. ser list (11/08/75). A full citation printout in "master list" format. A master list shows the content and field identification of each field in the MARC record. It is the most complete and reliable picture of a record that is generally required by systems catalogers.

4. Authority List (jsn, jos).

A listing of journal source for each article or reprint in the catalog.

5. Serials worklist, Areas by subject 11/09/75

A listing of journal titles and did numbers, in order by geographical area and subject terms.

6. Call Number List (06/26/76).

A cross reference list of volume call numbers and record did numbers.

7. Inventory List (04/09/76).

A list of book titles, in call number order, for taking a shelf inventory. Holdings notes are also printed (preceded by "noh").

8. Thesaurus Term Proof Sheet.

A list of each subject term in the catalog that is not a term in the TIS-CPC Population/Family Planning Thesaurus. The did number and field identification are given for each occurrence of the term, so that it may be corrected if necessary.

Preparation of this report required the availability of a thesaurus file in MARC format, so that term records could be generated for both catalog and thesaurus, interfiled, and the unmatched ones printed.

9. Tabulation of Subject Postings (05/07/76).

A listing of each subject term in the catalog with counts of the number of times it is used as a primary subject term ("sup"), a minor subject term ("sum"), and in both. This report is useful both for evaluation of indexing practices as well as in formulation of searches

based on subject terms.

This report illustrates the tabulation capabilities of the Print program. Note that the horizontal tabulation (columns) represent different tagged fields, not different values of a field.

c. Special purposes:

1. Inventory of Manpower Training, Frequency of Trainee Nationality.

A one-way frequency distribution of the values of a field or fields.

2. Inventory of Manpower Training, Frequency of Occupation by Category by Nationality of Trainee.

A three-way frequency distribution, in hierarchical format. In this report, each country was printed on a new page.
